



EDUSCRUM

We have already introduced EduScrum to you and we continue to teach in this way.

EduScrum was created by Dutch physics and chemistry teachers. They were inspired by Scrum, an agile technique that is mainly used in software development in IT companies. Scrum is based on teamwork, feedback and is particularly useful for solving complex problems. If used properly, it increases flexibility, speed of work or study or their quality.

As part of eduScrum, our students made presentations on AI (Artificial Intelligence) in their English class. At Dualka, this system has quickly taken root and we are actively using it in our teaching. We are happy that EduScrum is also popular with our students, who are clever, and it helps them with their English vocabulary, presentations, and overall public speaking.

ERASMUS+

Educational mobility in the transport company in Dresden, Germany

Second year students took part in a short-term Erasmus+ learning mobility in a transport company in Dresden, Germany.

Our 6 II.MM students - Martin Antal, Martin Partl, Martin Chudý, Mehmet Nuri Özkan, Erik Horváth and Radovan Vranek - took part in a two-week professional practice under the guidance of Matúš Deters and Miroslav Kadlec in the transport company of Dresden.

During the internship in Germany, the students visited various places of the transport company, worked and learned in the field of transport, mechatronics and electronics. They also practised their language skills as they communicated and cooperated with students or employees in different languages - German, English and Czech.

The aim of the mobility abroad is to extend the students' practical skills in vocational training directly at the Dresden transport company and thus increase their skills and knowledge in the field. We would like to thank all participants for the excellent use of their time, which was of great benefit especially for our students.







PITFALLS ON SOCIAL MEDIA

During November, a lecture and discussion on the pitfalls of social networking took place at our school.

Every day we are exposed to a lot of information. In addition to useful information, the Internet is also a source of hoaxes and misinformation. It is therefore important to pay close attention to this topic.

Vladimir Šnídl, a journalist who deals with the topic of hoaxes, propaganda, and the functioning of social networks, came to our school to explain the importance of this topic and to discuss it. The lecture was attended by selected classes of all grades.

The aim of the lecture was to develop students' critical thinking and to warn them about the threats posed by the dissemination of fake news, which lurks especially on the Internet and social networks.



TECHNICAL CONFERENCE ÚNMS SR

Dualka participated in the Technical Conference of the Slovak Republic Office for Standardization, Meteorology and Testing. It was an honour for us. The conference brought together a platform of experts who shared their knowledge and practice, as well as talked about current trends in technology, standardization, innovation, and cybernetics. It consisted of expert presentations, workshops and practical demonstrations focused on the use of technical standards in conformity assessment of machines and robotic systems.

Our freshmen - mechatronics, autotronics, and mechanical electrical engineers - computer science majors, were also able to join in the lectures and ask questions to the presenters. For example, we asked a question on the topic of cybersecurity and how to protect our home smart devices from hacker attacks. 




THE WINNER OF OUR STICKER COMPETITION - DANIEL SCHNEK


AUSCHWITZ

The students also visited the branch of the transport school, which is located directly in the depot of the transport company, where they had the opportunity to look into the nooks and crannies of trams. They saw several models of hydrogen cars built by students and competing with them in the Czech Republic and Slovakia. The technical instructors and teachers are enthusiastic about our students, they taught them simple modelling in PC and printing on a 3D printer. They also tried virtual reality, which allowed them to be in a model of a trolley-bus and see what it was used for.
