FOUNDING OF THE NEW CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANISATION (CSO) DUÁLKA o.z.

The new Civil Society Organisation Duálka o.z. will replace the non-investment fund ROZVOJ n.f.

Due to legislation, we are currently in a transition period where ROZVOJ n.f. is no longer able to receive contributions from the 2% tax donation and the CSO Duálka o.z. will only be able to receive them in 2025 for the 2024 tax returns.

The reasons for the change were mainly to consolidate and thus simplify processes, to create a single platform for DA and SSOŠA DA as well as to align the name with the Dual Academy brand.




SKILLS COMPETITION

- You met our employers Volkswagen Slovakia, Škoda, ZSE, Daikin Europe, Slovnaft and Motor-Car Group.








LENKA EXNEROVÁ -STUDENT'S MOTHER



DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION



During the first two months of 2024, we were able to finalise a complete hardware replacement for all employees of the Dual Academy and the Dual Academy Private Vocational Automotive Secondary School (SSOŠA).

As well as the migration to the common Microsoft 365 cloud environment under the common domain dualnaakademia.sk.

Thus, as of March 1, 2024, all DA and SSOSA employees have an active email address in the form of meno.priezvisko@dualnaakademia.sk.

Email addresses with the sosaba.sk extension are being redirected to these new mailboxes and we are preparing to close them. We are also preparing the activation of accounts for all students. We believe that this step will make communication between parents, pupils, pedagogical staff and non-teaching staff and the management of DA and SSOSA more efficient, smoother, and standardised.

We are currently working on consolidating internet connectivity throughout the building, as well as mapping key processes suitable for digitalisation and automation. In February, we launched an initiative to enhance the digital con of DA and SSOSA with an emphasis on the use of AI and its application in collaboration with the Kempelen Institute for Intelligent Technologies, the Slovak Academy of Sciences and Open Play, where we are preparing a series of lectures, and workshops on this very interesting topic. We will inform you soon about specific activities.

"I AM DELIGHTED THAT OUR PROJECT WILL FIND A PRACTICAL APPLICATION"

Close connection between secondary education and practical training of Volkswagen pupils studying at the Private Vocational Secondary School for Automotive Dual Academy, better knowledge of the environment, knowledge transfer and project work that is helpful directly in production practice. All of this came together at the flash station.

The practical training that our dual apprentices undergo at various plants in Volkswagen Slovakia brings positive benefits not only for the education of the apprentices, but also for the plants themselves. An example of such a connection is the flash station project in the pilot hall.

As part of their professional practice, the future graduates of the autotronics field of study, **Marián Haško** and **Tibor Kálozi**, are working on it. Their classmate **Alex Michalčík**, who is currently on rotation in the Quality Assurance Department, also had a hand in the beginning of the project.

"Flashing is writing a program to the control unit. The software of the storage unit can become outdated by deploying a new technical change, so it needs to be updated using flash. This is done by a station that provides the process of flashing and testing the control units outside the vehicle," explains Vladimír Sedláček from the pilot hall, under whose guidance the pupils are working on the aforementioned project.

The station was made by students using components commonly used in vehicle manufacturing Volkswagen Slovakia and other commercially available parts. The front panel and the individual covers were cut from aluminium sheet using waterjet technology. The internal electronics were constructed according to the design of the software station and the electrical schematics of the vehicles used in the pilot hall and electrical finishing. Connectors, also made by the students, are used to connect the concrete control unit and the flash station. The communication between the control unit and the station is done using buses such as CAN, FlaxRay and Eternet. "The students have an excellent opportunity to deepen their practical skills and theoretical knowledge in the field of car electronics and electrical engineering," adds Vladimír Sedláček.
