WHAT IS ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND HOW TO GET STARTED?

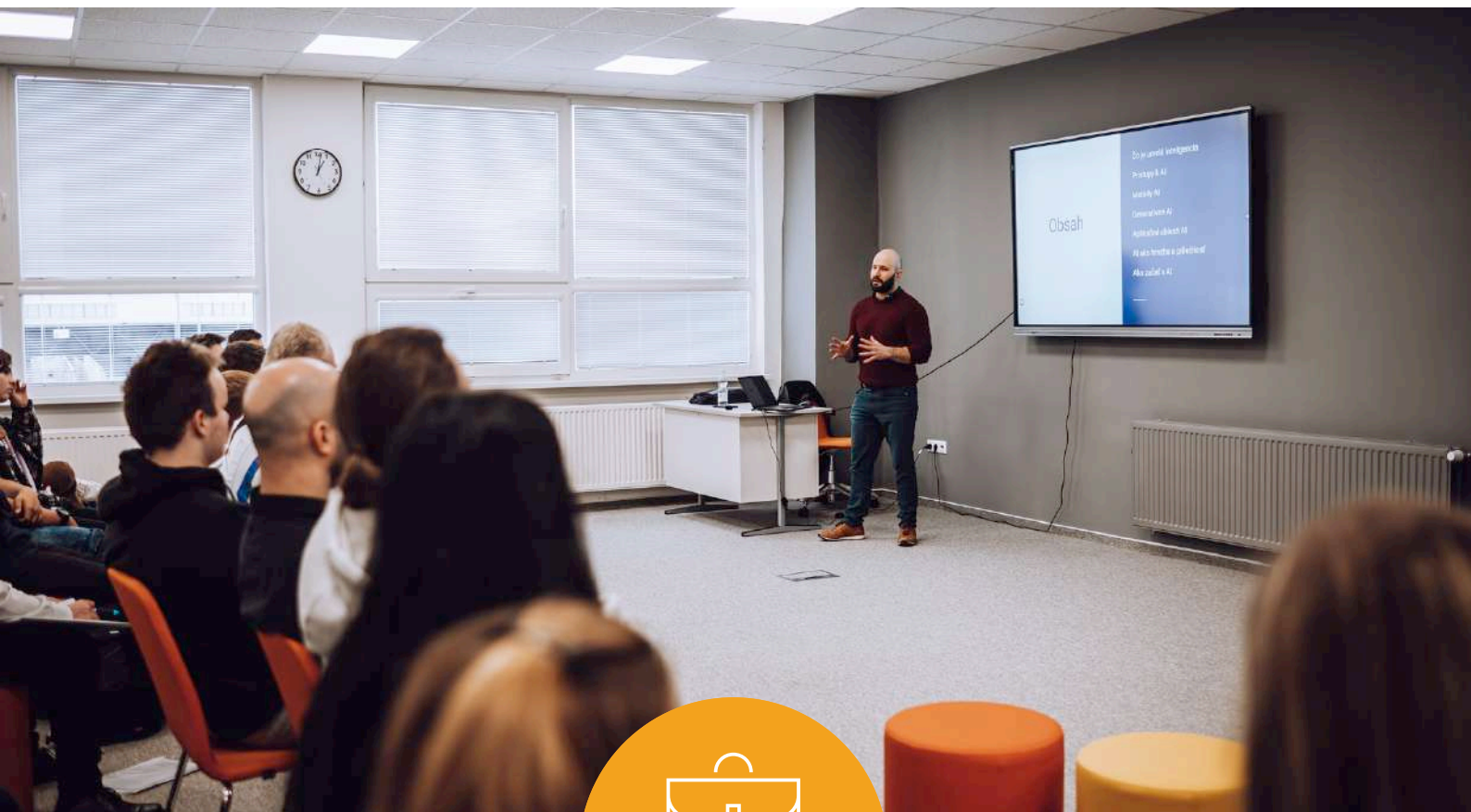
What is Artificial intelligence (AI)?

NEW FIELD OF STUDY - BILINGUAL TECHNICAL LYCEUM

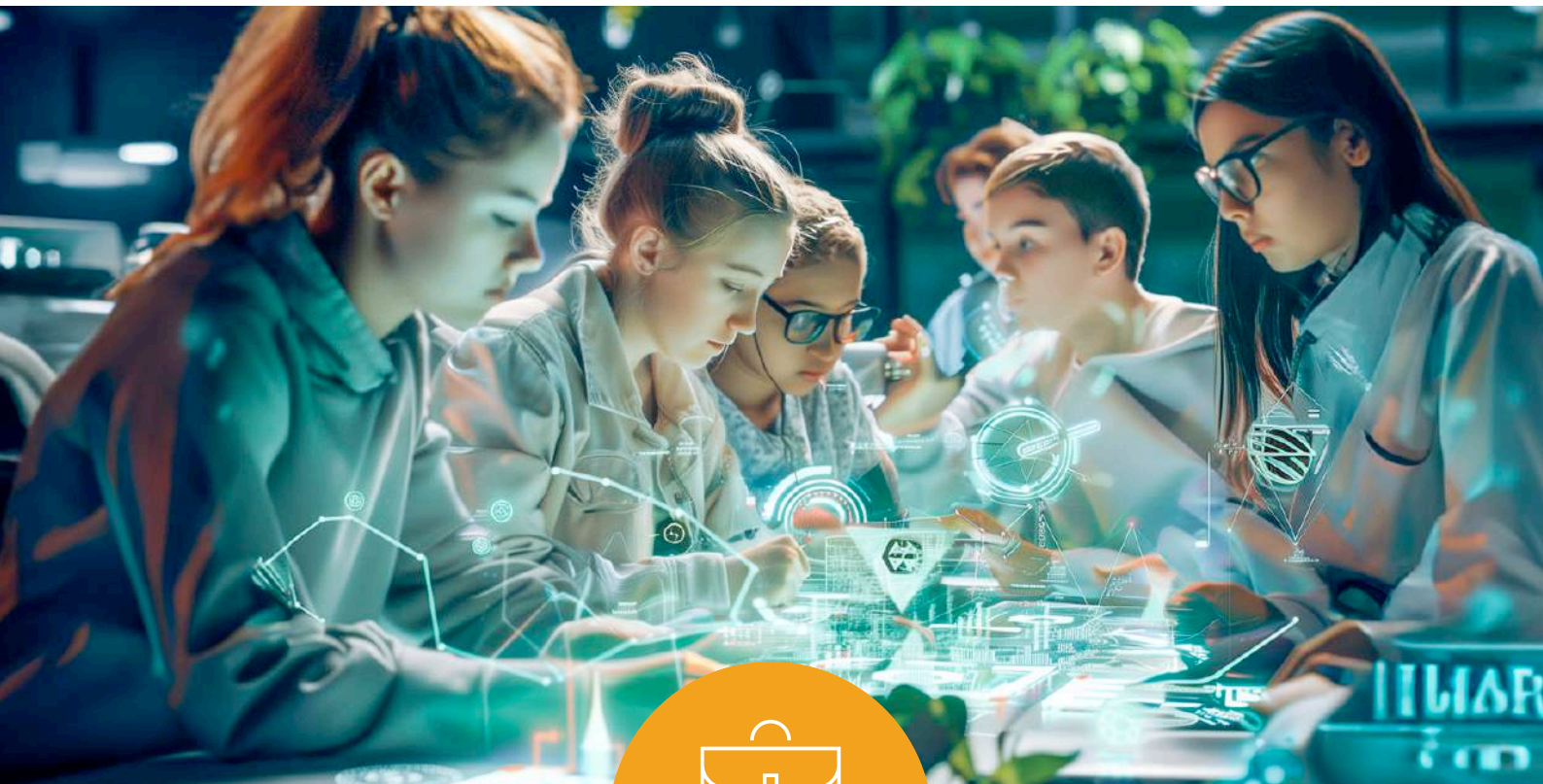
In March, we also managed to open a new field of study - Bilingual Technical Lyceum in English!

PROJECT WEEK AT DUAL ACADEMY

How did the pilot project week in Duálka go?

The purpose of the project week is to teach students to think and connect knowledge from multiple subjects through project-based learning so that they can use it to create their own project. Our freshmen computer science majors and freshman, sophomore, and junior auto technicians participated in project week.

The autotronics students diagnosed malfunctions on cars and analysed the functionality of individual parts. They did everything on real cars. They used diagnostics, schematics, and measurements. A great advantage, but also a challenge, was linking several subjects, working in a team, and bringing the knowledge to the final presentation. Although they worked in teams, everyone contributed their skills, thus using their full potential.

The aim of the project week for the professional computer scientists was to create a single- page website using HTML and CSS. Throughout the week, students were divided into groups, using online tools to study basic commands and work on the assignment.

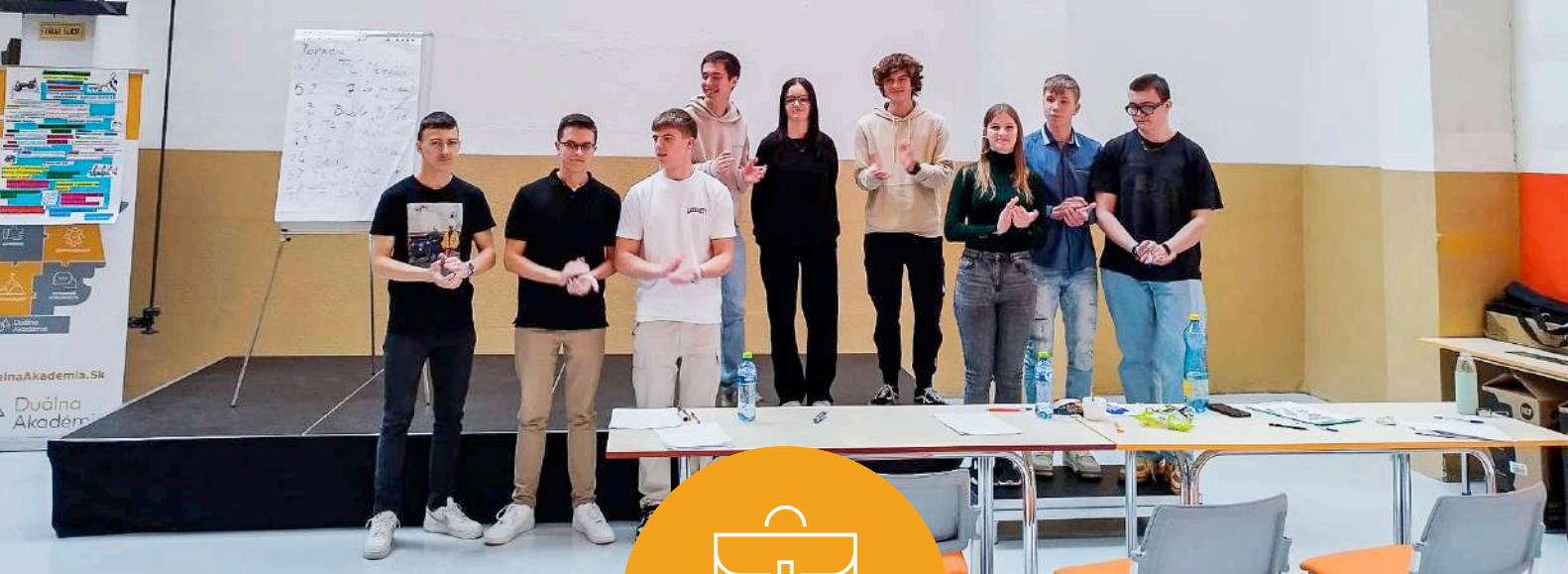
At the end of the week, the participating students presented their project and its results in front of a professional jury, which consisted of teachers or masters. 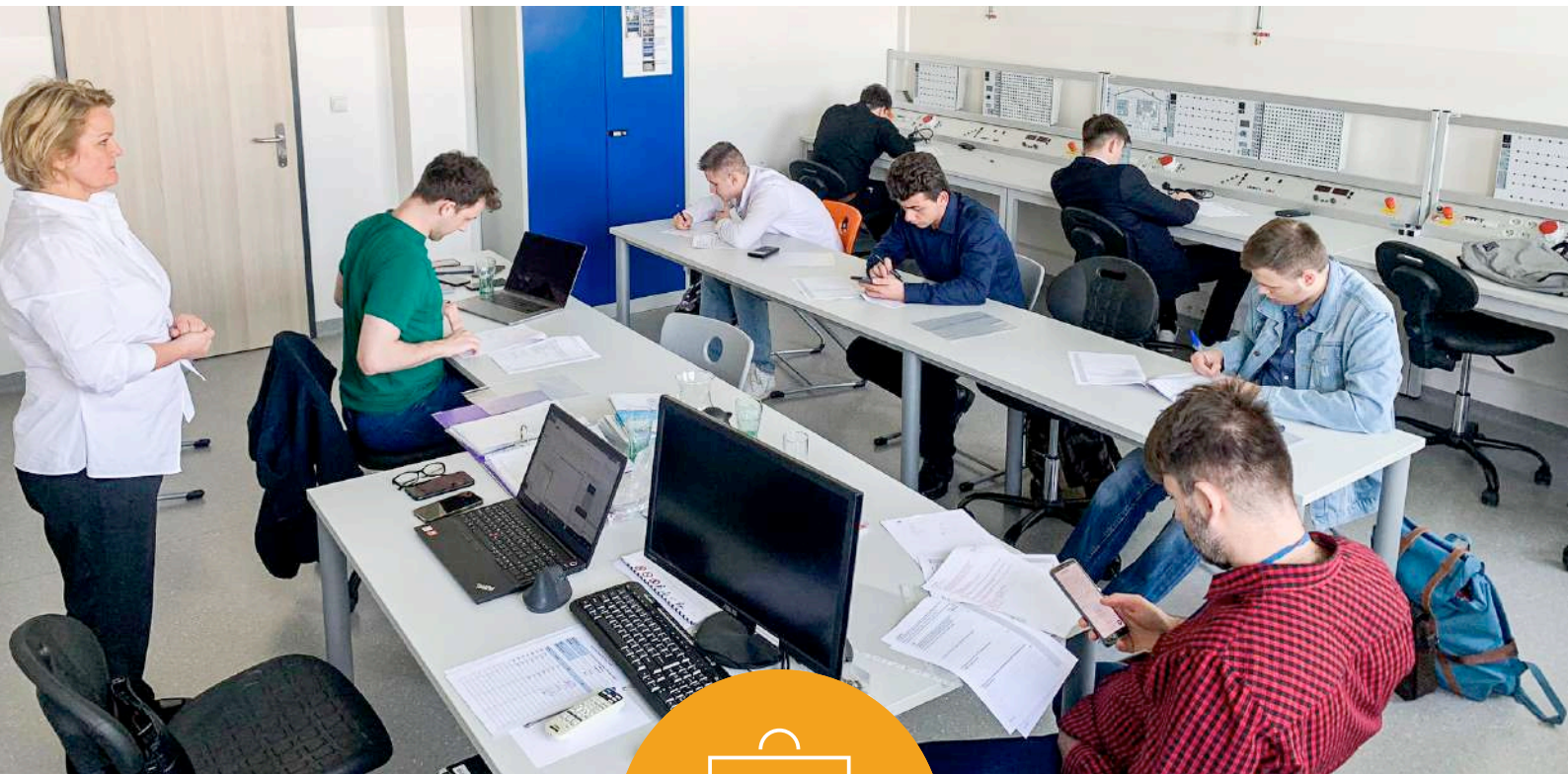
AP2 FINAL GERMAN EXAMS

April was marked by the AP2 final German proficiency exams, after which successful graduates will receive a recognised and well-ranked certificate.

As many as 55 students tested their theoretical knowledge in the fields of mechatronics mechanic, electrical mechanic, computer technician, automotive technician and machine and plant mechanic.

Students take the AP exams twice during their studies - in the middle (AP1) and at the end of their education (AP2). During the first examination, the students' current state of knowledge and skills is ascertained, and the final examination links the practical part with the final practical examination. Both in the written and in the practical part.

We keep our fingers crossed for all the students during this important week and hope that they will successfully obtain their certificate, which will be of great help to them after school, thanks to the knowledge they have acquired. We hope that by passing the AP2 exams, they will also approach their work responsibly, as they did when they were studying at Dual Academy.



Did you know that writing a proper CV is not that easy? And did you know, that AI, or artificial intelligence, can help you do it?

Thanks to Lucia Steller from Stell+ERP s.r.o., our students have discovered new ways to use AI not only in their studies, but also, for example, in creating their own CVs and job searches. During the workshop, the students tried their skills at how to write a proper CV. They then entered it into the software and analysed it against their desired profession. In addition to being able to help in how to better describe certain skills, knowledge or abilities, the software also offered students recommendations on what they should be able to do in the profession.

We thank Lucia Steller for an interesting and thought-provoking workshop that will hopefully help our students in their job search. The feedback from the participants shows that the workshop was very well received. As they said, they liked the software, which also gave them spot-on ideas on what to improve, but it was also a new experience with AI that they will definitely use in their lives.

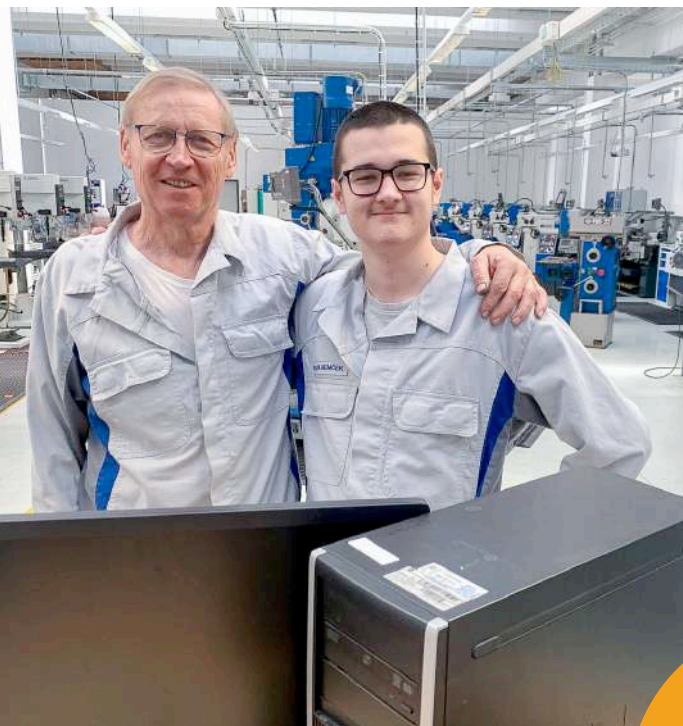

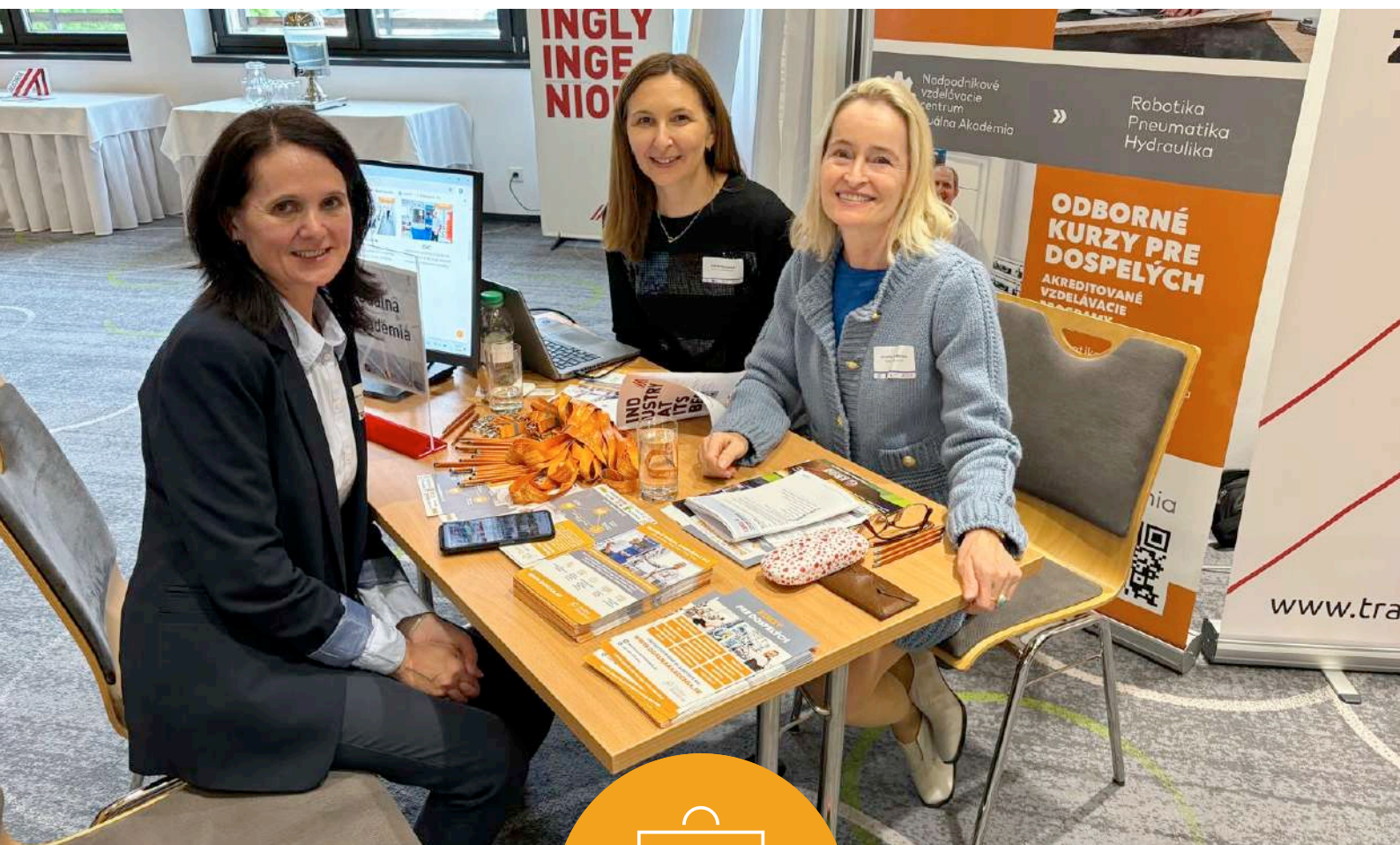
AUSTRIAN-SLOVAK COOPERATION EXCHANGE 2024

We also had the opportunity to get acquainted with new potential partners, to present our offer to companies or to learn more about their business and cooperation interest in Slovakia. Thank you!



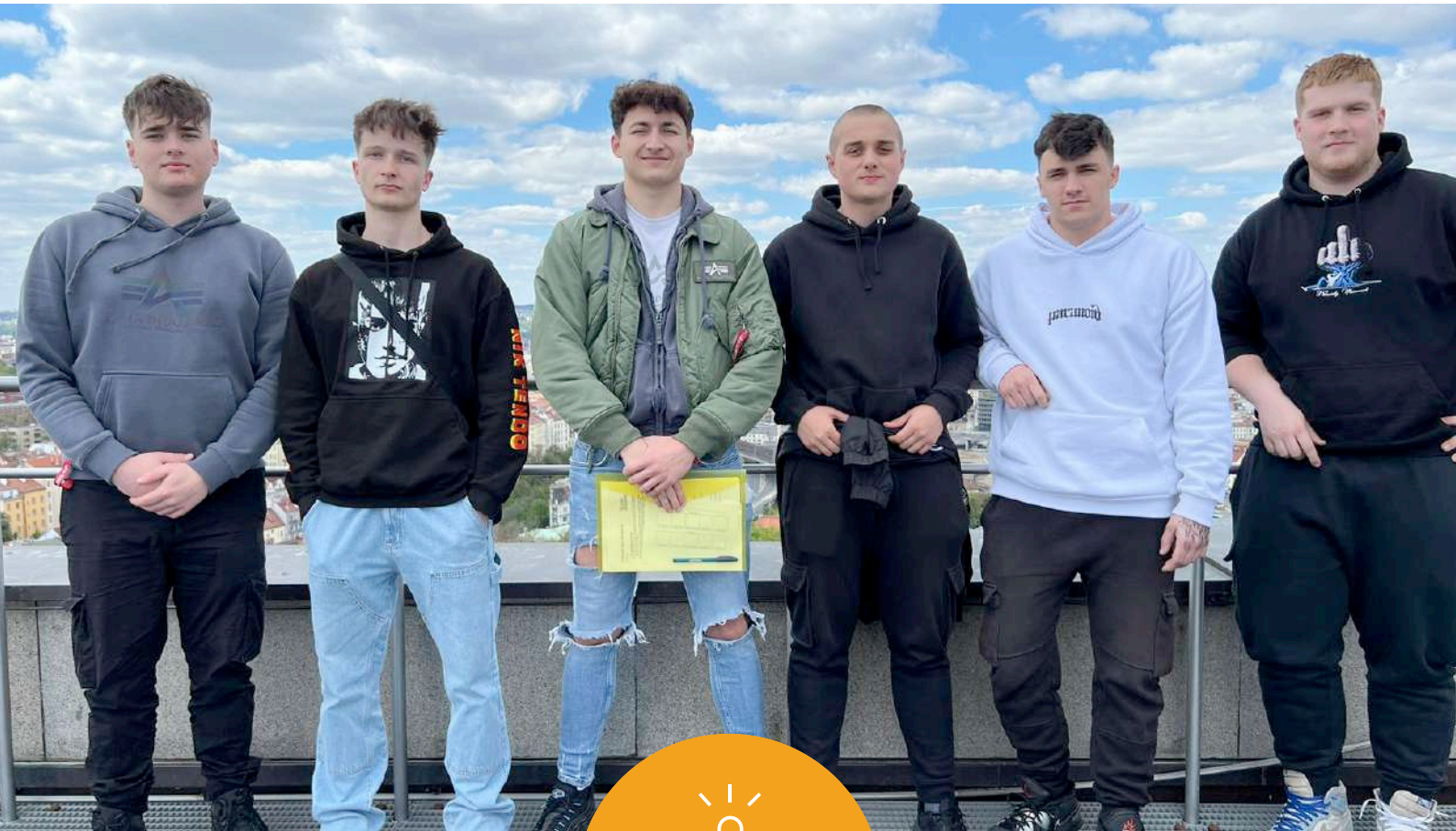
