SUMMARY

In May and June 2024, several significant events and achievements took place at the Dual Academy, which we are proud of:

First Global Slovakia competition: The Duálka team won 2nd place at the FIRST Global Slovakia 2024 competition! They will represent Slovakia at the FIRST Global competition in Athens.

GreenPower Slovakia competition: Our students triumphed at the Greenpower Slovakia race, winning 1st place.

My Machine Slovakia project: Our students built a multifunctional watering machine called Sprinkler Jano. The device combines the functions of a waterer, birdhouse, clock, water mist sprayer, and bubble blower.

Energy Festival in the Piešťany Power Plant: Our students won 1st place in the sympathy award and 3rd place in the official competition evaluated by representatives of ZSE!

Ceremonial end of the school year: We celebrated the end of the 2023/2024 school year with a graduation ceremony, where we handed over certificates, awarded students with excellent results, and handed over diplomas to participants in various competitions. We also announced the **student of the year, Adam Kollár,** and handed over the **first yearbooks of the Dual Academy.**



EDUCATIONAL STAY IN PORTUGAL

Our students completed an educational stay in Portugal in May.

Thanks to our Portuguese partner Mobility Friends and the Erasmus+ program, we participated with 14 other schools from 9 countries. Almost 120 students also enjoyed a themed evening, on the occasion of the 12th anniversary of Mobility Friends, with a local folklore ensemble, where the youth had a perfect time.

Also, the students, under the guidance of teacher Alfréd Bauer, participated in the Olympiad, where they worked in mixed teams. It aimed to promote integration, improve communication and cooperation, and support the international nature of mobility. Some of our students were members of the winning team and some were in a team that placed 3rd. They were happy not only with material awards but also with the award of a symbolic rooster.



May 2024 NATIONAL FINALS OF THE COMPETITION CANSAT SLOVAKIA 2024

In May, the Duálka team participated in the finals of the CanSat 2024 competition under the auspices of the Slovak Space Office.

We thank the whole team for the successful representation of the Dual Academy. The finals took place at the airport in **Malé Bielice** and were attended by 14 teams from all over Slovakia. The team leader was **Ing. Igor Mozolák**, who exemplarily faced the challenges in the finals together with our students. They have learned much this year and are looking forward to next year.

Our team's task was to build a satellite the size of a can. The scientific goal was to measure ultraviolet radiation and air humidity. During the final, the satellites were carried to an altitude of approximately 1 kilometer by drone or balloon, where the satellite's main mission occurred: to conduct a scientific experiment or demonstration of the technology, land safely, and analyze the collected data.

Our student, Filip Jerg, from class III.A has attended a regional round, in the field of car repairer. We are proud that the Dual Academy regularly participates in various competitions and thus gives space to shine to young talents and their skills.

It is also a tool for motivating pupils to learn the trade of a car repairer and, by highlighting the craft, to ensure the recruitment of pupils to the apprenticeships of car repairers.

PREPARATION FOR THE SLOVAK LANGUAGE GRADUATION EXAMS

Our students 3.MM, 3.ME and 1.MM visited the Ľudovít Štúr Institute of Linguistics SAS.

They also prepared for the school-leaving exam in the Slovak language in this experiential way, which awaits third-graders next year, too. As part of the excursion, they learned about the history, functioning and individual sections of the Institute of Linguistics, learned about the dictionaries published by the Institute, and also got acquainted with the Slovak National Corpus.

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INTERVIEW WITH THE EMPLOYER ZÁPADOSLOVENSKÁ DISTRIBUČNÁ, A.S.



Answering: Mgr. František Adamkovič

Head of the Operations Department **Západ v spoločnosti Západoslovenská distribučná, a.s.**

He has been with the company since 1993. Cooperation between ZSE and the Dual Academy began in 2022.

Why should a student choose your company as his/her employer in dual education? Name three reasons.

Job stability, a possible career shift (that is conditioned by the gradual acquisition of professional competence), and thirdly, a good salary.

What are the most significant new developments that have recently taken place or are planned in your company?

In the last two years, we have built two training "BABY" polygons at partner schools as part of dual education, which simulate the basic parameters of LV distribution networks to a lesser extent. On polygons, all our graduates of dual education and professional practice can try working on such a device in a de-energized state. To ensure the practical part, we have also created the position of the main instructor of vocational training this year, where, together with our own master of vocational training operating in Bratislava, they ensure the complexity of dual education in all regions of our company's activity in the West Slovakia region.

Can you tell the readers something about your company that nobody knows, or that they don't just read on the internet?

It is probably no longer news that Západoslovenská and Východoslovenská energetika have recently merged into one company and thus we have become the largest and strongest energy company in Slovakia. It is less known that in our company colleagues can also realize themselves in various non-energy areas, for example, we have a lot of opportunities for our employees in the field of sports, volunteering, and few people know that our company has, for example, a band called Energetic Music Formation (EHF) or a club for feeding cats, crows and :). It is said that whoever has been employed in ZSD once, then works there until the end of his/her career.





INTERVIEW WITH THE EMPLOYER ZÁPADOSLOVENSKÁ DISTRIBUČNÁ, A.S.

If you had to describe your company in one word, what word would it be?

From the point of view of the operations division and the placement of dual education graduates, this is "complexity".

How do you select your future students in the Dual Academy? What should a student be skilled in, what do you look for when selecting candidates?

When selecting candidates, we try to motivate the candidate and elucidate the attractiveness of the study of heavy-current electrical engineering. At an age when young people are deciding where to go to high school, it is understandable that most of them do not have real knowledge and experience of what their future work in the electrical engineering industry is about. When recruiting candidates, we verify their basic skills, personality traits, and, if possible, a real interest in working as an electrical engineer in our company. This is probably the most difficult thing in the beginning when choosing them.

What benefits do you offer to students of the Dual Academy?

The standard is PPE equipment of the same quality as all our electrical engineers. Productive work is entitled to a financial reward according to the current rules and a meal allowance according to the actual days worked on practical training. A scholarship associated with good results in vocational subjects taught at the school. An inseparable non-financial benefit is the opportunity to attend training for employees during their studies, as well as many excursions such as e.g. dispatching of LV, HV, HV, a visit to the Malženice steam-gas power plant, 110/22kV electrical stations and many others.

What is the student's perspective within your company or does your company have a plan for working with graduates? Can you share with us some success stories?

For recent graduates or those within 2 years of graduation from secondary school or university, we offer the POWER graduate program that is already well-established in our company. It is a system of quarterly rotation of graduates. At individual workplaces, they acquire basic knowledge and skills about working in the power industry. At the same time, it also serves to verify the skills as well as the choice of the graduate himself, where, after induction, he can start his first permanent job, whether it is a production, operating part at LV, HV networks transformer stations, electrical stations, electricity meter service. After acquiring the necessary experience and professional competence according to the current needs of our company, they can later apply for management positions such as coordinator, construction manager, or support activities such as construction calculators, energy equipment managers, etc.
